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Welcome to the Health Services Department of Anderson School District Two

Health Services would like to make you aware of the guidelines for medication administration during the school day and other important information about the health and safety of our students. All forms referenced in the following information are available on our website.

- Students are **NOT** allowed to carry any medication on them or in their book bag during the school day unless they have an **“I. Authorization for Medical Procedures at School Form / II. Self-Administration and Self-Monitoring of Procedure Form”** signed by the parent, physician and student on file with the school.
- If your child requires prescription medication to be given during school hours, the medication must be brought to the health room by the parent in its **original container labeled with the student’s name**. A **“Prescription Medication Consent Form”** must be signed by the parent/guardian and physician.
- Non-prescription medication (ex. Tylenol, Motrin, etc.) can be given during school hours, but must be provided by the parent/guardian in its **original container labeled with the student’s name along with a signed “Non-Prescription Medication Consent Form”**.
- Antiseptic spray/ointment, medicaine swabs, sore throat spray, topical tooth anesthetic, anti-itch spray/cream and antifungal creams are over-the-counter medications that can be provided for students by health services and will be kept in the health room. **These medications can only be administered by the nurse and only if the “Medication During the School Day Form” is signed by the parent/guardian**. If this form is not signed, no stock over-the-counter medication will be dispensed to the student.
- Every parent should complete the **“Student Health and Emergency Information Sheet”** each year. This form is kept confidentially in the health room. Please notify the school’s health services if any of the information should change during the school year.
- Parents are advised that ASD2 Health rooms do not stock EpiPens. Parents are encouraged to bring an EpiPen to your child’s nurse in the event one is needed.
